

School Interviews Questions

Below I outline example questions which may arise in an independent school entrance interview at 11+ or 13+ entry level.

In the lead up to the interview it is a useful exercise to have a discussion with your child to consider how they may answer these questions should they arise; however, it is important that your child is authentic and natural, they must not appear scripted or over-rehearsed.

In the interviews masterclass I discuss example responses to some of the below questions.

I have highlighted in grey the most commonly occurring/popular questions which are likely to arise.

Questions about you

- 1. What is your favourite subject and why?
- 2. What is your least favourite subject and why?
- 3. How was your weekend? What did you do over the weekend?
- 4. What did you do over the summer/christmas holidays?
- 5. What are your three best qualities?
- 6. What is your greatest achievement at school?
- 7. How would your best friend describe you?
- 8. How would you form tutor/teachers describe you?
- 9. What is your worst trait?
- 10. How would you rate your behaviour at school?
- 11. Do you speak any other languages?
- 12. If you had a day to yourself, no school, no parents telling you what to do, what would you do? /How would you spend the day? (or two hours to yourself)
- 13. Do you like watching TV?
- 14. Do you enjoy movies? What is the last movie you watched or your favourite movie?
- 15. Tell me about your favourite holiday destination.
- 16. What do you want to be when you are older?
- 17. What would you like to achieve in the future?
- 18. What new things would you like to try?

- 19. Of all the places you've visited, which would you most like to return to? Why?
- 20. Do you have a best friend? What is he/she like?
- 21. Would you describe yourself as an active person?
- 22. In ten years, what do you think you will be doing?
- 23. What are your ambitions?
- 24. What do you want to do when you leave school/ when you are older?
- 25. Do you enjoy performing in front of an audience? What experience do you have with performing? E.g., dance, drama, music, singing or public speaking
- 26. Are you religious?
- 27. Do you prefer working in small groups or working on your own?
- 28. Do you have any idea yet what career you might be interested din when you are older?
- 29. Is there anything about you that you have not had a chance to tell me yet?
- 30. Have you experienced any moments of disappointment?
- 31. What is your favourite animal? Why?
- 32. If you could go on holiday tomorrow, which country would you like to visit and why?
- 33. What would you like to achieve in the future and what new things would you like to try?
- 34. Describe a situation you have found difficult and how did you resolve it and find a solution?
- 35. What is your biggest dream?
- 36. What are you proudest of in your life?
- 37. If you could have lunch with anyone in the world, who would you choose?
- 38. Have you enjoyed this interview?

Questions about your family

- 39. Tell me about your family.
- 40. Do you have any brothers or sisters?
- 41. Do you get along with your brother/sister?
- 42. Tell me about your sibling/s
- 43. What activities do you do as a family?
- 44. Are you close to your family?
- 45. Do your family have strengths, achievements, contributions to make to the school community?
- 46. What qualities do you think make a good friend?

Questions about your current school, extra activities & hobbies

- 47. Tell me about your hobbies and interests
- 48. Are you involved in sport, music, drama, art, design & technology ...what have you achieved in these areas?
- 49. Do you like your current school?
- 50. Do you like to play sports?
- 51. What after school activities do you do?
- 52. What have you been doing in class recently that particularly interests you?
- 53. Have you been involved in house competitions and volunteered to do something which is not particularly your strength, for the benefit of the House?

Questions about the prospective school

- 90. What is the difference between your school and this one? Do you think they are quite different?
- 91. Do you think you might have any difficulties at this school?

- 94. Do you think you will enjoy being at this school?
- 95. If you were taught well by our teachers, would you work hard?
- 96. If you were a pupil at this school, how would you contribute to school life?
